Gillware Data Recovery

I have used Gillware a few times. I found the info on their website to be extremely accurate and forthcoming. They did not charge me for a drive they couldn't recover (physical damage) and they even let me browse the files to make sure what I needed was available before paying them.

We have recommended The Data Recovery Room out of Seattle before (206.575.7773 <http://recoroom.com>) with reasonable results. I met with a guy in Hayden that is offering some data recovery services, Ben Keele of QualityByte Computers (208.714.4221 <http://www.qualitybyte.com>) but I haven't heard of anyone using his services.
