Usually, we tell you about what happened this past week; for this bulletin, we want you to know what is happening this coming week.

On Wednesday, December 19, the Board will be meeting in executive session to discuss a restructuring proposal collaboratively developed by the Collective and consultant Paul Lipscomb. The reason the Board will take it up in executive session instead of a public meeting is because it will be impossible to avoid a confidential discussion of possible personnel implications for individual current Collective members. However, the minutes of the Collective's December 6 meeting (<http://lists.freegeek.org/pipermail/minutes/2012-December/001453.html>) contain some details about the Collective's recommendations.

The Collective has requested that the Board make a definite decision about whether their recommendations will form the framework for restructuring work moving forward; the Board has committed to doing so at their Wednesday meeting. As a consequence, in our next bulletin, we should be able to give you a lot of information about what Free Geek's new management structure either ***will*** look like or ***will not*** look like.
